
Did You Know?

Health & Human Services In Palm Beach County

Did you know that there are 230,000 Palm Beach County residents living below the poverty level? For those residents, life is a continuous struggle forcing many with daily choices most BallenIsles residents have never had to face.

- Do I pay the rent **or** replace the shoes my children have outgrown so that they can go to school?
- Do I repair my car to be able to get to work **or** pay the electric bill?
- Do I take my child to the dentist or replace a needed pair of eye glasses?

Many families and children face these and other types of questions every day. Their challenges are varied, ranging from unemployment, inadequate



- **Adopt-A-Family** --funding for its program to supply school uniforms, backpacks & class room supplies for children in transition;
- Caridad Center -- funding for its program providing dental care for under-privileged children;
- Clinics Can Help -- funding for the purchase of medical equipment used by patients who may not otherwise be able to afford expensive equipment for their physical recovery;
- **Gratitude House** -- funding for its treatment program for expectant mothers with drug or alcohol addictions:
- **Jerome Golden Center** -- funding for the purchase of equipment to enhance the capabilities of its visiting healthcare professionals;
- National Council of Jewish Women -- funding for the purchase of clothes to be placed in school closets for students attending Title 1 Schools; and
- The Jacob S. Zweig Foundation -- funding for the purchase of 500 pairs of shoes to be given to children in need.
